- Welcome/Call to Order by Craig Cantrell, 1st Jaime Waxter, 2nd Brandi Selman
 - Craig Cantrell introduced the band program
 - Showed the importance of the arts with studies/articles

 - Talked about the CBBA Facebook page
 - Displayed how to navigate the band website for concert band and marching band.
 - Revealed the show for 2024/2025 school year-Pirates theme
 - o Dragonfly is showing only for the current school year. Go ahead and fill it out and it will roll over. The middle schoolers going to high school next year might have to do something to update later, but we will let them know when the time comes.

• President's Report:

- Motion to accept new executive board officers with Dawn Doyne as VP1 to replace Jaime Waxter and Jennifer Bishop as VP2 to replace Brandi Selman, 1st, Abby Carr, 2nd Katy Leary
- Courtlan McQueen provided an update of the tower being built on the practice field. Explained what the tower is for and the need for it. Phase 1 is nearly complete and phase 2 will include a second story with a roof to be built as budget allows.
- Explained the importance of parent volunteers and that we have increased the requirement to 2 shifts per family. We have an additional home game this year.
 Volunteering will include needs in concessions, spirit wear, moving of equipment, towing trailers, chaperoning, etc.

• 1VP Report:
